Weekly Confessions: One hour before every Mass; Every Saturday : 3:30 pm to 4:30 pm

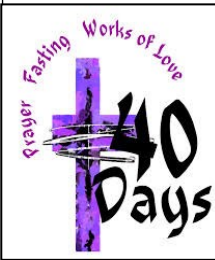
Penitential Celebrations: Two are celebrated each year, in Advent and in Lent.
