MARCH; SUFFERING and FAMILY BURDENS GOD’S MERCY and FORGIVENESS THE CROSS. But from everlasting to everlasting the Lord’s love is with those who fear him, and his righteousness with their children’s children. Psalm 103:17.

March 6—Certain silences are oppressive, even at times within families, between husbands and wives, between parents and children, among siblings. Without love, the burden becomes even heavier, intolerable. I think of elderly people

living alone and families who receive no help in caring for someone at home with special needs. “Come to me, all who labor and are heavy laden,” Jesus says. **March 7** - Sadly, in this world, with all its highly developed technology, great numbers of children continue to live in inhuman situations, on the fringes of society, in the peripheries of great cities, and in the countryside. **March 8**— There is no place for the elderly or for the unwanted child; there is no time for that poor person in the street. At times, it seems that for some people, human relations are regulated by two modern “dogma”; efficiency and pragmatism.
