**A YEAR WITH POPE FRANCIS ON THE FAMILY.** Daily Reflections. Jesus, Mary and Joseph.

**MARCH; SUFFERING and FAMILY BURDENS GOD’S MERCY and FORGIVENESS THE CROSS.** But from everlasting to everlasting the Lord’s love is with those who fear him, and his righteousness with their children’s children. Psalm 103:17.

**March 12—** If you go to him with your whole life, even with the many sins, instead of reproaching you, he will rejoice; this is our Father. This you must say ; say it to many people, today. Whoever experiences divine mercy is im-

pressed to be an architect of mercy among the least and the poor. **March 13** - The wisdom of our grandparents is the inheritance we ought to receive. A people that does not care for its grandparents, that does not respect its grandparents. Has no future since it has lost its memory.

**March 14** — Adultery has always been considered a grave sin, even if only desired it has been punished severely because it was seen as comparable to violating the covenant. Thus, Israel differed from other cultures and religions in giving adultery a public dimension; it was seen as offending not only against the private institution of matrimony but also against divine law.
