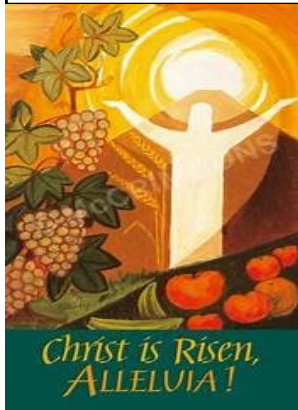

**Gathered as ONE in the name of Jesus, we welcome you to Annunciation B VMParish. Due to COVID-19 restrictions, things are a little different in our church than what you have been used to. We're following all regulations to make worship safe for all. We keep in our church social distancing, hand sanitization, and face masks. Behind every greeter's masks is the same big smile you've seen on each visit to our parish. Services are at a 15% capacity of the building which equates to approximately 30 persons. Come join us for a weekend or weekday Mass.**

**FUNERAL IN CHURCHES - A CLARIFICATION:** With the colour zones in effect in our area, a funeral in a church according to the Bereavement Authority of Ontario (BAO) is allowing 15% capacity to a maximum of 50 people in the Grey Zone or 30% capacity to a maximum of 100 people in other zones. This limit does not apply to our Sunday or other Masses—but only for funerals or funeral Masses in a church at this time. I would ask all our parishes to abide by this norm until we are given other directions by the BAO or the Ontario Government. Please cooperate with our Funeral Directors and with their guidance. If you have any questions please thje Pastoral Centre. Thank You.

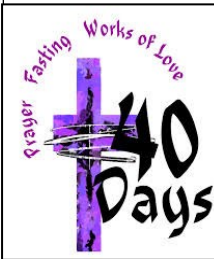
**Weekly Confessions:** One hour before every Mass; Every Saturday : 3:30 pm to 4:30 pm
