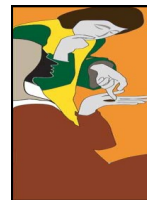
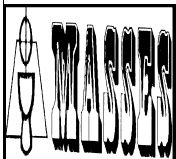

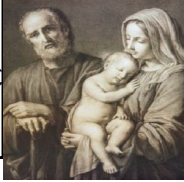

Today's feast celebrates our belief in the presence of Christ in the universe and sets it in a tension with the demand that we then be the vehicles by which that presence is made manifest. It is his presence in us that makes the demands of disciple-ship upon us that we must proclaim him. The mystery of ascension is that his presence with us and our witness to him cannot be separated.

But do we take his presence in the universe seriously? Do we believe he is present in every poor person, every sick person, every prisoner? Mt 25:34-46 can be read as the 'other side' of this mystery: in today's texts we think of the beginning of the ascended presence of Christ in the church; in Mt 25 we have a reflection on the eschaton and when that presence in the disciples ceases. Do we take seriously the notion that there is no area of the universe from which Christ's presence is excluded? So Christ is present in every creature (see Jn 1:3) and in every aspect of human life. 'To be witnesses' (manures) and 'proclaim' (kiruxate) were key terms for the early church: one was descriptive of what they must be, the other a command as to what they must do. But, by the second century, both were very expensive words. A misty sweet image of Jesus floating away, alongside an arcane discussion about 'whether you can trust "the bible"' in its creative poetic narratives such as Acts 1, fails to do justice to this mystery on both counts.
