Reopening Churches: Welcome to the New Normal: Churches in Thunder Bay are will officially be opened next weekend with a 30% capacity of the facility. Our Annunciation Blessed Virgin Mary Parish can accommodate at least 42 participants. All participants must wear a mask, use hand sanitizer and follow the directions given to all worshippers. The directions/ guidelines will be announced prior to the Mass. There will be some masks available for those who forget. You are encouraged to wear your own masks. Hand sanitizer will be available in the church. Sunday offering is to be placed in the basket provided at the church entrance. There will be no formal collection taken during the Mass. For those who would like to participate in the weekday mass at 10:30 a.m. (at Annunciation Blessed Virgin Mary Parish) you are welcome. If you are sick, please avoid participation. Precautions: (for participation in the Mass) - please wear your masks. We may have a limited supply, provided the order arrives. Hand sanitizer is available in the church. Since there will be no cups served, for the time being we will not be requiring Eucharistic ministers during the Mass. Lectors, please follow the schedule for proclaiming the Word.

*If you have travelled outside Canada within the past 14 days, please do not enter the church until any medically directed self isolation has been completed.

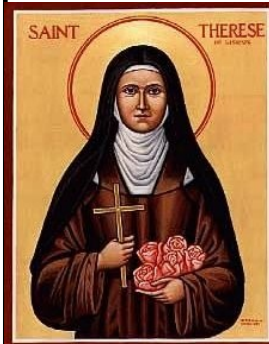
*You are strongly encouraged to wear a mask upon entry into the church.

We thank you for sending us teachers like Jesus, so gentle and humble in heart that we find rest for our souls; they lay a yoke on us but it is easy, they ask us to bear a burden but it is light. Lord, we thank you for the gift of St Thérèse of Lisieux. Truly you revealed things to this mere child which you hid from the learned and the clever among her contemporaries, yes Father that is what it pleased you to do; – she knew that whatever she had was entrusted to her by you, – she felt herself known by you in a way that no one else knew her, – she knew you as no one else knew you, and those to whom she taught her Little Way, – she called to her all who felt religion as a labour and a burden and she gave them rest; – we have learnt humility and gentleness of heart from her and we found rest for our souls; – we found her yoke easy and her burden light. Today's passage is best understood as a wonderful summary of the "Little Way" of St Thérèse of Lisieux.



For those who are acquainted with the spiritual teaching of the Saint, it is an opportunity to celebrate her and all she has meant to the Church and to the world of our time
