

**YEAR OF ST. JOSEPH.** My soul yearns for You in the night, my spirit within me keeps vigil for You. There s a hunger for Go. God needs to be rediscovered not through theological definitions but in the mysterious rhythms of the universe. For many, God is found in the silence between the notes of a beautiful piece of music, or in the crevices along the side of a massive mountain, or in the silence of the night. St. Joseph, give me confidence in knowing that God is as close to me as my breath.

If you had understood the words, "I desire mercy and not sacrifice," you would not have condemned these men who are without guilt. Justice and mercy meet in compassion. There is no doubt that abiding by the law of the land can bring about justice for all. When laws are broken order must be restored, but sometimes mercy can occasion a return to order more readily than the application of the principles of strict justice. St. Joseph, help me to balance out my sense of justice with compassion.

Funeral Masses may also again be celebrated in our Cathedral with the 15% capacity and (for now) a cap of 60 people. This 60 person cap also applies to Services in Funeral Chapels and for cemetery burials.
