Annunciation BVM and St. Hilary Parishes are a community of Catholics under the guidance of the Holy Spirit. We proclaim the Good News of Jesus Christ through worship, service and fellowship, in cooperation with the Bishop of Thunder Bay, in order to bring forth the values of the Kingdom of God.



We are given the context of today’s story: it took place as Jesus was “returning from the district of Tyre”. He was passing “by way of Sidon towards the Sea of Galilee” and this brought him “right through the Decapolis region”. This reminds us that we must know how to leave our ordinary surroundings so that we can meet people like this man.

Today's gospel passage is a healing story. We must be careful to interpret these stories correctly. For example, we would be wrong to draw the conclusion that since Jesus healed miraculously, all his followers are called to do the same. That would be to misunderstand the meaning of the miracles. St John gives us the key to interpret Jesus' miracles.

Whereas the other evangelists refer to the miracles as "wonders" or "powers", John calls them "signs"; for him the miracles point beyond themselves to the "kingdom of God". This is the world as God wills it to be. It is what Jesus lived and died for. The miracles therefore are living lessons on the kingdom. They are also signs that the kingdom is already present in the world.

We can see fleeting glimpses of it, its first fruits, its heralds.

My paternal grandparents had thirty-five grandchildren, thirty-six great-grandchildren and one great-great grandchild. What a progeny! Our family reunions were the best, and it was wonderful to see how close we remained. That's the way it should be with God's family. St. Joseph, keep us close to the Holy Family so that we may never forget our true family roots.

Before I formed you in the womb I knew you. Before you were born I dedicated you. A prophet to the nations I appointed you. All of us have a prophetic role to play in the world and in the Church, e.g. on school boarders, city council, and parish advisory committees. The pursuit of honesty, integrity, and transparency in all these areas can be very prophetic in a world of clandestine politics and religious hypocrisy.

Funeral Masses may also again be celebrated in our Cathedral with the 15% capacity and (for now) a cap of 60 people. This 60 person cap also applies to Services in Funeral Chapels and for cemetery burials.



The person in this story can neither hear nor speak and is therefore a truly touching symbol of those who cannot communicate. They cannot hear God's word of truth, wisdom and consolation, the words of those who would like to enter into communication with them. They cannot hear the life-giving words spoken by nature, the truth of themselves, the greatness or the weakness of their own beings. The "impediment" in his speech symbolizes well our inability to initiate conversation - with God, other human beings, nature, oneself.
