

We proclaim the Good News of Jesus Christ through worship, service and fellowship, in order to bring forth the values of the Kingdom of God. When we think of Jesus preaching we think of people flocking to hear him, just as today we gather to re-affirm our identity as his people gathered now at his table. But in today's gospel we hear of people being sent out from Jesus to prepare his way before him. We gather now, but we are also the people he has charged to prepare his way in the world today. To be a disciple is not only to fol-

low, but to go ahead of the Lord announcing his presence. Let us reflect on these twin aspects of being Christians: following the Lord, and presenting the Lord to the world. We are called not only to be 'disciples' but 'apostles'. Although Jesus is fully aware that his journey to Jerusalem will end in his passion and death, he is also aware that the mission to proclaim the good news is one that must be continued. In Luke's gospel, which is probably more Gentile than the others, the theme of the universality of Jesus' message is more to the fore. We can see one of the ways that is shown in the fact that seventy two disciples are sent out to prepare the way for him. In the ancient world it was believed that there were seventy two nations on earth and so this is symbolic of a mission to the whole world.

**Men, do you feel a special call to serve the Church?** The vocation to the permanent diaconate is a call from God and enriches the Church's ability to carry out her ministry of word, and liturgy, of charity and justice. The ordained ministry is open to men between the ages of 35 and 65. A new 4-year formation program will begin in 2020 in Thunder Bay. 
