Money has to serve, not rule. Money has to serve, not rule! The pope loves everyone, rich and poor alike, but the pope has the duty, in Church's name, to remind the rich to help the poor, to respect them, to promote them. The pope appeals for disinterested solidarity and for a return to person-centered ethics in the world of finance and economics.

Question: I have wanted to invite my fellow Protestant friends to mass. How do I explain the holy communion to them and whether or not they may participate in the communion on a non "holiday" mass?

Answer: The statement by the American bishops on Communion says the following concerning Protestant Christians: "We welcome our fellow Christians to this celebration of the Eucharist as our brothers and sisters. We pray that our common baptism and the action of the Holy Spirit in this Eucharist will draw us closer to one another and begin to dispel the sad divisions which separate us. We pray that these will lessen and finally disappear, in keeping with Christ's prayer for us "that they may all be one" (Jn. 17:21) Because Catholics believe that the celebration of the Eucharist is a sign of the reality of the oneness of faith, life, and worship, members of those churches with whom we are not yet fully united are ordinarily not admitted to Holy Communion. Eucharistic sharing in exceptional circumstances by other Christians requires permission according to the directives of the diocesan bishop and the provisions of canon law (Canon 844.4)."In short, communion has a "horizontal" as well as vertical dimension. It is communion, not only with God, but with the Church and is a proclamation that we are one in body, mind, and spirit. Since Protestants are not in full union with the Catholic Church, it is not appropriate to receive communion and thereby declare the opposite by one's actions. Therefore, the Church asks that our separated brethren refrain from receiving communion at mass. However, the Church does encourage visitors to receive a priestly blessing. To do this, simply join the communion line with arms folded across the breast (hands on shoulders) and the priest will gladly give a blessing. May God hasten the day when our divisions are ended and we may be of one heart and mind in the Church.
